Emergency Ordinance 07-0202

All persons who are present within the Town of James Island are required to wear an appropriate face covering any time they are in contact with other persons who are not household members in indoor public places and indoor businesses where it is not possible to maintain a six-foot distance from others or where social distancing is not or cannot be being practiced. This includes the following: While entering or inside any retail, restaurant, office or other business location or inside any government building or facility under the jurisdiction of the Town. All business and organizations within the Town of James Island are required to comply with this Ordinance, which is applicable to patrons and employees. Exceptions: in outdoor or unenclosed areas where six-foot social distancing can be maintained; for those who cannot wear a face covering for medical reasons; for children under five years old, provided that adults accompanying children age two to five shall use reasonable efforts to cause those children to wear Face Coverings where six-foot social distancing is not possible or observed, for patrons of restaurants or similar locations while seated and dining or drinking, or while standing and maintaining a six-foot social distance, in private offices; in settings where it is not practical or feasible to use a face covering.
