

A RESOLUTION FROM THE JAMES ISLAND INTERGOVERNMENTAL COUNCIL
REGARDING INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT FORT JOHNSON AND
SECESSIONVILLE ROADS

WHEREAS, governing bodies representing James Island meet on a biannual basis to discuss the issues facing the James Island community as a whole; and

WHEREAS, this body strongly believes the intersection at Fort Johnson and Secessionville Roads warrants intersection improvements in the form of a stop light; and

WHEREAS, our residents, businesses, and institutions have requested on numerous occasions safety and traffic improvements in the form of a stop light; and

WHEREAS, SCDOT has performed traffics studies and feel at this time an intersection improvement project at this location is warranted; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the James Island Intergovernmental Council requests that the CHATS Board add the project for current or future Transportation Improvement Project funding.
