Cubby to check with Ernest Parks to see if he has photo of Little Rock Golf Club. Site 20 also loose red line. AK to send a picture of avenue of oaks they can try to use. Skipper has scanned in pictures Inez had of schools and will provide. A consensus on the cover photo was to use a modern-day photograph of McLeod slave cabins. The back cover should be a solid color.
