New Business:

- **SC250 Charleston** – Sester-centennial Commission (SC250) to celebrate and promote the state's role in the American Revolution by educating, engaging, and inspiring South Carolinians and visitors. Statewide initiatives include development of historic sites, increased public access to historical markers, expansion of the Liberty Trail, and research and publications about key topics such as the experiences of women, African Americans, and Indigenous persons, in addition to prominent leaders. SC250 is coordinating with committees in each county to discover and celebrate significant people, places, principles, and events of the Revolution. The commission is offering grants for local activities, education, and events supported by the county committees. www.southcarolina250.com
