

RESOLUTION 2013-22

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR FUNDS FROM CHARLESTON COUNTY'S FY 2015 TRANSPORTATION SALES TAX ANNUAL ALLOCATION PROGRAM

WHEREAS, new construction projects to be included in Charleston County's FY 2015 Transportation Sales Tax Annual Allocation Program will be approved via a competitive allocation process and there is a January 1, 2014 submission deadline for potential projects; and,


WHEREAS, the Town of James Island is working with the Charleston County Department of Public Works on the design and construction of a sidewalk on Camp Road to connect the sidewalk on Fort Johnson Road to the sidewalk at Dills Bluff Road; and,

WHEREAS, the total estimated cost for this project is \$136,200 and the Town is hereby authorized to match 10% of the project cost in an amount not to exceed \$15,000, which is available for expense in the Town budget;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JAMES ISLAND TOWN COUNCIL THAT:

1. An application for the FY 2015 Transportation Sales Tax Annual Allocation Program is hereby authorized for pedestrian/bike enhancements on Camp Road.
2. This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and approved.
