A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THE APPROVAL AND INSTALLATION OF TURN SIGNALS AT THE MAYBANK HIGHWAY AND WAPPOO CREEK DRIVE INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, citizens throughout James Island, including those residing in the Town, have brought attention to numerous safety issues pertaining to the intersection of Maybank Highway and Wappoo Creek Drive entering in and out of the James Island Shopping Center;

WHEREAS, this intersection is already heavily traveled during all seasons of the year a new major high density development in the immediate area will cause a significant increase in traffic; and,

WHEREAS, the Town of James Island seeks to improve traffic flow and safety in all parts of James Island, cooperating with other government jurisdictions including the State of South Carolina, the City of Charleston, Charleston County, and the James Island Public Service District;

WHEREAS, Maybank Highway is a South Carolina Department of Transportation roadway and the intersection with Wappoo Creek Drive is under the City of Charleston jurisdiction;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE JAMES ISLAND TOWN COUNCIL THAT:


This resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and approval.




