## A RESOLUTION REGARDING SOUTH CAROLINA ACT 624 OF 1986

WHEREAS, South Carolina Act 624 was proposed by former Representative Derwood "Woody" Aydlette, Jr., ratified by the 106<sup>th</sup> South Carolina General Assembly Session and later signed into law by then Governor Richard Riley in 1986; and

WHEREAS, South Carolina Act 624 states, "In Charleston County, the entire lengths of Regatta and Grand Concourse Roads, and the paved portion of Harbortowne Road to the point it deadends on Regatta Road and the pavement ends, are added to the State Highway System. The remaining unpaved portion of Harbortowne Road must be closed by the Department of Highways and Public Transportation";

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of James Island supports the upholding and enforcement of Act 624.
