A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT SCDOT INSTALL SIGNALIZATION (STOPLIGHT) THE GRIMBALL EXTENSION AND FOLLY ROAD INTERSECTION

WHEREAS, the Town of James Island Council has received requests from citizens regarding safety issues at the Grimball Extension and Folly Road intersection; and,

WHEREAS, Folly Road is a heavily traveled road during all seasons of the year and several high density developments recently have been approved by the City of Charleston close to this intersection that will cause a significant increase in traffic; and,

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that the Town work with the SCDOT to improve traffic flow and safety for local residents and all drivers who use our streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF JAMES ISLAND COUNCIL THAT:

The Town requests that the SCDOT consider the installation of signalization (stoplight) at the Grimball Extension and Folly Road intersection.
