

A RESOLUTION REGARDING LIBRARIES ON JAMES ISLAND

WHEREAS, Charleston County Plans to place a referendum on the November 2014 ballot for \$105 million to construct new libraries and renovate existing libraries; and


WHEREAS, \$20 million is being allocated for a new library on the Folly Road corridor at a yet to be determined location; and

WHEREAS, The Charleston County Library Board has proposed closing the James Island Branch Library on Camp Road – a community library that has effectively served the needs of those in the surrounding neighborhoods for over thirty years;


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of James Island requests that Charleston County include a specific location for the new library in the Folly Road corridor on the ballot question, while renovating the existing James Island Branch Library on Camp Road. The branch library should remain open as a more convenient location for many Island residents.

This Resolution shall become effective upon its adoption and approval.
