RESOLUTION TO SOUTH CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION (SCDOT) IN SUPPORT OF INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT FORT JOHNSON AND SECESSIONVILLE ROADS

WHEREAS, the Town of James Island Council has received numerous requests from its citizens regarding safety issues at the intersection of Fort Johnson and Secessionville Roads; and

WHEREAS, Fort Johnson and Secessionville Roads are heavily traveled at all times; and, in light of new development, the additional homes will contribute greatly to the traffic at this intersection, and have already begun to do so; and

WHEREAS, it is in the public interest that the Town of James Island work with the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) to improve traffic conditions for the safety of all who travel our streets;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TOWN OF JAMES ISLAND COUNCIL THAT:

The Town requests that the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) conduct a full Traffic Study to determine if the intersection meets the requirements for signalization; and if the requirements are met, that the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT) consider the installation of a stop light at the intersection of Fort Johnson and Secessionville Roads.
