**A RESOLUTION FOR THE ADOPTION OF THE REPETITIVE LOSS AREA ANALYSIS REPORT
BY CHARLESTON COUNTY COUNCIL**

WHEREAS, the Town of James Island has experienced the effects of natural and man-made hazard events;
and

WHEREAS the County Building Inspection Services Department, which provides services for the Town,
has prepared a recommended *Repetitive Loss Area Analysis Report* in conjunction with the Community
Rating System and Five-year Floodplain Management Plan with Woolpert; and


WHEREAS, the recommended *Repetitive Loss Area Analysis Report* has been widely circulated for review
by residents/business organizations/professional organizations of the unincorporated and incorporated areas
of Charleston County, state, federal, regional and local government agencies and has been supported by
those reviewers; and

WHEREAS, the Town of James Island is required to adopt the report and all amended versions of this
report on an annual basis if changes occur for the Town to remain eligible for certain Federal programs in
which the Town participates,


NOW, THEREFORE, be it resolved that:

1. The *Repetitive Loss Area Analysis Report* is hereby adopted as an official document of the Town
of James Island, and
2. The Charleston County Building Inspection Services Department is recognized as a continuing
entity charged with reviewing, maintaining in accordance with Community Rating System and
National Flood Insurance program requirements, and periodically reporting on the progress towards
and revisions to the plan to the Town of James Island Council.
