IV. Update on recommended tree list

Mrs. Woolsey and Mr. Tomblin discussed the lack of diversity on the native tree list. Both suggested the addition of fruit trees such as fig & pecan.

Mrs. Woolsey and Mr. Tomblin will continue to edit the recommended tree list and bring back to the council at the next meeting.

V. For the good of the order

Mrs. Woolsey initiated a discussion of the Asian Longhorned Beetle and the recent activity of the USDA to curb the spread of the invasive insect in South Carolina. The beetle attacks hardwoods, mainly maple trees. The beetle was discovered in May/ June in South Carolina and an effort has been underway by the USDA to seek out infestations and destroy infected trees.

The Chairman suggested adding an educational section to the town website to alert the public the recent infestation of the beetle with information on how to spot the beetle and who to contact if they should find evidence of beetle infestation.
